COURSE DESCRIPTION: This 40 hour course is designed to provide the student with the basic knowledge and skills necessary to provide effective in-service training for mounted patrol officers in the areas of horsemanship and law enforcement mounted patrol tactics. This course will provide students with a thorough understanding of the responsibilities of a mounted training/officer. The course will also develop skills necessary for the successful preparation, coordination, and documentation of mounted patrol training.

PREREQUISITES: (1) Member of, or sponsored applicant for, a Law Enforcement Mounted Unit or Posse, (2) Mount must meet their unit's requirements and be in good health w/ current vaccinations, (3) Rider must be in good physical health. Rider must be able to walk, trot and canter their horse under control, and be familiar with their tack and equipment, (4) **Rider must have completed a POST 40-hour Basic Mounted Patrol Course (proof of completion will be required).**
